What it IS

- An act preventing the National Guard from deploying to foreign wars without a declaration of war by the U.S.
 Congress (US Constitution - Art I, Section 8)
- An act ensuring the US
 Constitution is adhered to and
 enforced by the states who
 formed the Federal
 Government on behalf of the
 people (Bill of Rights, 10th Amendment)

What it IS NOT

- An attempt to harm the National Guard, but rather to prevent them from deploying to endless wars
- Risky it's simple: follow the U.S. Constitution as required by oath and affirmation

This Bill Will NOT Affect The Following:

- Funding
- Force Structure (Bases/Equipment)
- Pay and Benefits
- Overseas Training
- The Commander in Chief's ability to rapidly respond to national defense priorities at home or abroad
- The Governor's ability as the Commander in Chief of the State's National Guard to engage in drug interdiction or respond to emergencies (MT Constitution Art VI, Sect 13)
- Readiness if readiness sufferers, there's a leadership issue in the National Guard

This is one of the most constitutionally aligned bills for which

legislatures will vote. A vote for HB404 is to support the many

National Guardsmen and women across Montana who wish

they could be here to testify in support.

Resources Available

What is not allowed

- The Adjutant General for the State of Montana cannot lobby for or against pending legislation when in uniform and representing the Dept. of Defense. They also cannot use resources to gain favor with legislators, such as offering helicopter flights, or other resources at taxpayer expense.
- This is true regardless of the topic and is a long-standing tradition understood at the most junior levels across the military. Appearing in uniform at the hearing or any lobbying efforts leading up to the hearing and before any floor session vote violates DoD Directive 1344.10 and The Hatch Act.
- Such actions can lead to punishment under <u>Article 92 of the Uniformed</u> <u>Code of Military Justice</u> (Failure to Obey an Order or Regulation)
